



The 2021 Edition of the High Plains Rally is set for **Thursday, September 30th**. It is our hope that this will give all of our school teams the time to get their cars and teams ready. The races are again held at West Frontier Park. This venue has everything we need; restrooms, an good race course, shelter houses for handling the events and the food and power in the right places. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, spectators will be allowed only in designated areas.

Representatives from Kansas Electrorally and Fort Hays State University's Department of Applied Technology have met to discuss the planning of the event. Those attending this meeting will participate with the needed items and manpower to make the event a success. I know we value their time and effort. Please take the opportunity to thank your representatives of these sponsoring organizations.

This is again a year dominated by concerns of COVID-19. So, we need to some of the same things this year. Please help us out by doing the following.

- Make sure all participants have an approved facemask and that they wear it when working or communing or in the presence of other persons.
- We realize that members of individual teams have been and will be in close proximity to each other.
- Teams and team members should not congregate with other teams. Teams will be expected to stay in their pit areas prior to the start of the heats. The pit areas and lap counter tables will be set up to accommodate social distancing.
- We need to know which teams will be attending. We need to know the number of persons (students and coaches) for each team. This will help us arrange times to register and check, in as well as how many individual meals to order.
- Only the team drivers and representative are allowed in the registration area at their assigned time. Registration is extended to 3 hours (7:30 to 10:30) for this event.
- During the race heats, teams will either be in their pit areas, or in the infield of the track observing social distancing.

What makes this event so successful, year after year, is the participation of all the teams. The coaches, team sponsors, and the team members should all be given special kudos and thanks for the dedication they have to Kansas Electro Rally Racing, and to each other. Even in these trying times, you all are getting it done!

### REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION

- Registration begins at 7:30 AM September 30<sup>th</sup>, inside the small shelter house at the West end of West Frontier Park.
- Each team member and advisor will properly complete a liability release form for this year and turn it in to the race registrar.
- Each team advisor will complete registration forms to register all cars and teams in all race categories and sign the registration form.
- Each driver will be weighed with ballast and the weight recorded on the registration form.
- The registrar will sign the registration and will keep all the above mentioned forms in a team envelope.
- All teams will receive two (2) copies of the race map.
- Inspection of race vehicles begins at 8:00 AM at the staging area.
- When inspection is completed, the inspection papers are returned to the registrar and kept with the registration papers for that car/team, after which a decal for 2021 is issued. Only cars with a race decal for 2021 will be allowed to race.
- Do not forget to fill out the appropriate Consent and waiver forms. ALL participants must provide these properly completed and signed.
